New Student Orientation is offered at the following locations: Toledo Campus, Findlay Campus, and The Downtown Learning Center.

New Student Orientation is a two-hour session, so please plan accordingly.

Please arrive 15 mins early for check in.

New Student Orientation is only for the student enrolling.

No children are allowed in the session.

When you arrive for New Student Orientation, check in at the following locations:

- Toledo Campus: College Hall 130 A
- Findlay Campus: Information Desk in the Atrium in the Education Center
- Downtown Learning Center: Front Counter

- Bring a copy of your photo identification.
- Know your 9-digit Owens College ID number (OCID).
- Know your Ozone username and password.
