- **Avast:** avast! Linux Home Edition represents an antivirus solution for the increasingly popular Linux platform. The Home Edition is offered free of charge but only for home, non-commercial use. <http://www.avast.com/linux-home-edition>
- **AVG:** Basic antivirus protection for Linux/FreeBSD available to download for free. Free virus protection for your PC. <http://free.avg.com/us-en/download.prd-alf>
- **Clam AV:** ClamAV is an open source (GPL) antivirus engine designed for detecting Trojans, viruses, malware and other malicious threats. It is the de facto standard for mail gateway scanning. It provides a high performance mutli-threaded scanning daemon, command line utilities for on demand file scanning, and an intelligent tool for automatic signature updates. <http://www.clamav.net/lang/en/download/packages/packages-linux/>
