

How can I learn more about New Student Orientation?

New Student Orientation (NSO) is a required program for all first-time certificate or degree seeking students at Owens Community College who are new to Owens and have less than 9 successfully completed transfer hours. **In order to participate in New Student Orientation, you must have completed an Owens Application and completed the ACCUPLACER test or have submitted your ACT scores to Owens.**

How to Prepare:

- Bring a copy of your photo identification.
- Know your 9-digit Owens College ID number (OCID).
- Know your Ozone username and password.
