

How do I sign on the Owens WIFI network as a Guest user?

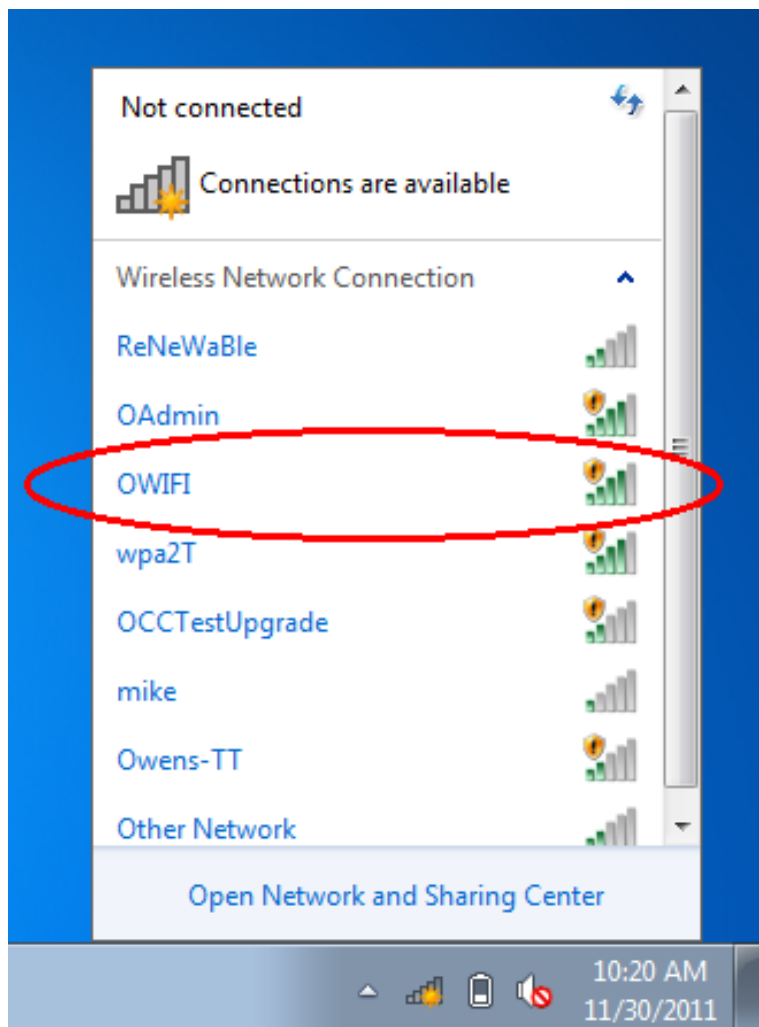
1. Locate the wireless connections icon located in the bottom corner of your screen.



Right-click on the connections icon to bring up a list of available connections.

2. Find **OWIFI** on the list of connections.

NOTE: Connecting to another network on this list is potentially dangerous, if you decide to connect to one of these rogue networks, YOU ARE CONNECTING AT YOUR OWN RISK!

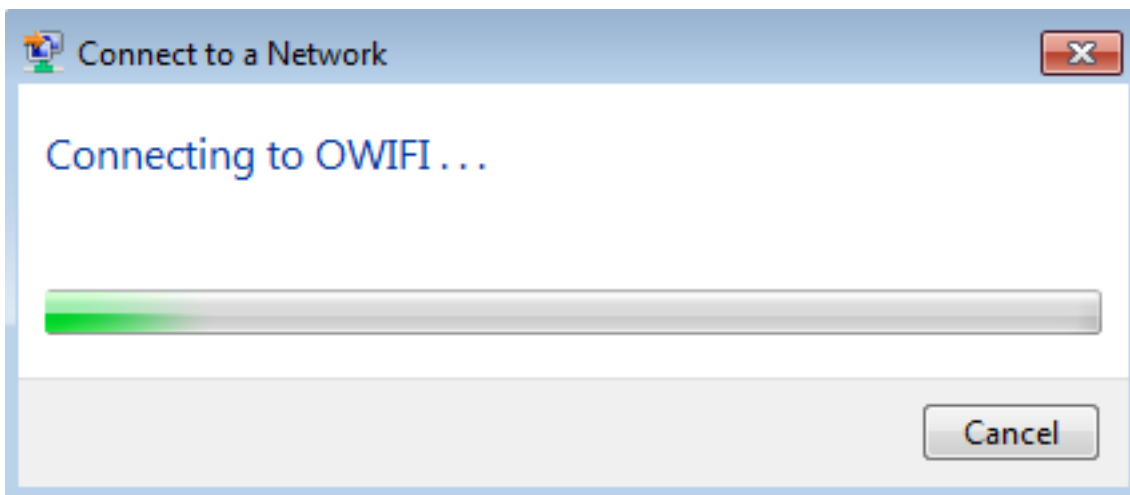


3. Click on **OWIFI** and a **Connect** button will appear.



If you would like your computer to automatically connect to OWIFI whenever the network is in range, check the box next to **Connect automatically**. To connect to the wireless network, click **Connect**.

A box will pop up briefly telling you that your computer is connecting to the Owens wireless network:



4. Once you are connected, open your browser of choice (Internet Explorer, Mozilla Firefox, Google Chrome) and you should be presented with a log-in screen.

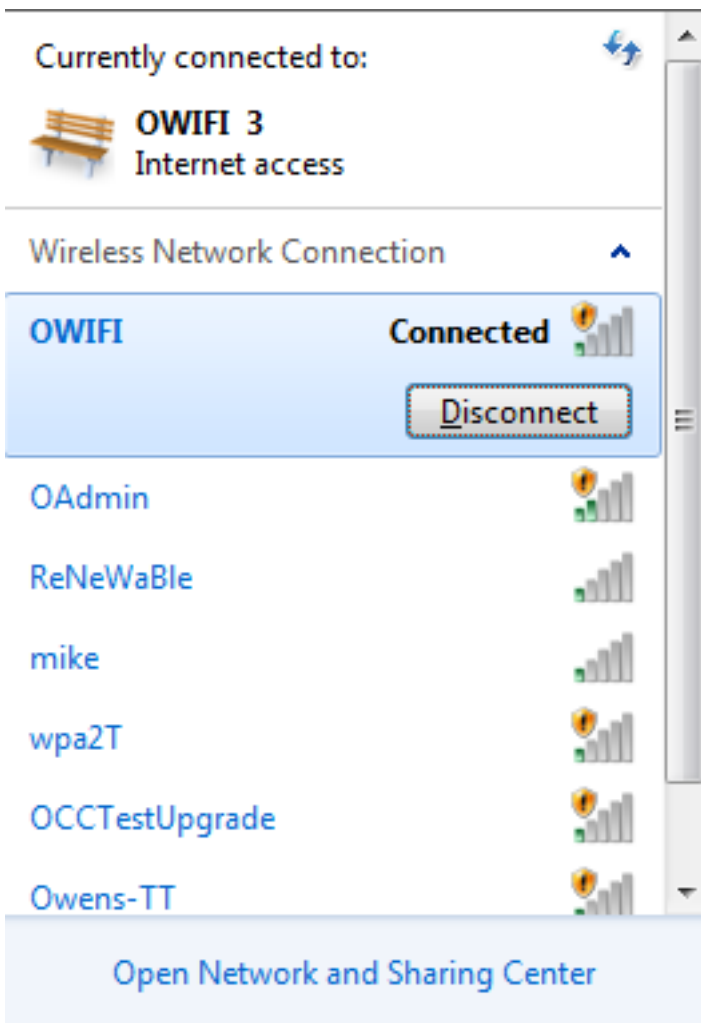
Owens Community College ("College") provides access to distributed and local networked resources as a service to the campus community. It is the intent of the College that all technology resources will be used in accordance with any and all local, state and federal laws and/or guidelines governing the use of information and technology with this and other policies and procedures of the College, and with standards of professional and personal courtesy and conduct. Implicit in this is the expectation that all students, faculty and staff will utilize the information and technology resources of the College so as not to waste them, abuse them, or interfere with or cause harm to other individuals, institutions or companies. Access to the College's information and technology resources is a privilege that may be wholly or partially restricted by the College without prior notice and without your consent when required by and consistent with law, when there is substantiated reason to believe that violations of policy are taking place, or when required to meet time-dependent critical operational needs.

5. To disconnect from OWIFI, right-click on the wireless icon in the bottom corner of your screen. Click on **OWIFI** on the connections list and you will be presented with a **Disconnect** button. Click this button to disconnect from the Owens wireless network.
